Regional Waterline Construction to Start at Stickney Elevated Storage Tank in April

Impacted Landowners

Impacted landowners are essential to the success of this project, and RCWD has been adamant that they are informed throughout the process. Hausmann-GE, the design-build contractor, has committed to:

- Providing clear and timely updates regarding any construction activities on impacted property.
- Minimizing disruption to land and property while prioritizing safety and quality.
- Maintaining open lines of communication to address any concerns or questions landowners may have.

After extensive planning, the Regional Waterline 'Connecting Neighbors' project is moving forward with pipe delivery and earthwork scheduled to commence in April, spring weather permitting.

The construction sequence is planned as follows:

- Begin pipe delivery and installation at the Stickney Elevated Storage Tank and work east to the Mitchell connection. *(Spring 2025 - Spring 2026)*
- From the Stickney Elevated Storage Tank working south and west towards the Platte Tank Farm. *(Fall 2025 - Spring 2027)*
- The Platte Treatment Plant Improvements are anticipated to begin summer 2025 with overall completion by summer 2026.

The design-build delivery method accelerates the project construction timeline from the traditional design-bid-build 4-to-5-year approach to just 3 years while reducing costs by an estimated 20-25%. As a result, the overall waterline completion is expected by summer 2027.

RCWD's 72-mile high-capacity transmission line will deliver clean, reliable water to two existing customers, Aurora-Brule Rural Water System, and Davison Rural Water System. The project will also expand to provide the City of Mitchell with a redundant water source. Along with these three primary project participants, RCWD will also incorporate strategic connections to improve water delivery and reliability for existing customers.
